

Fabry Disease Symptom Checklist

If you have experienced any of the symptoms below, check the appropriate box. This can help you discuss your symptoms with your doctor.

- Acroparesthesia:** a burning, tingling, or numb feeling generally felt in the hands and feet

- Pain Crises:** intense pain that is often felt initially in the hands and feet and radiates to other parts of the body

- Fever:** typically unexplained and is recurrent

- Angiokeratomas:** a reddish-purple skin rash, generally in the area from the belly button to the knees

- Impaired Sweating:** decreased ability to sweat/perspire when exercising or exposed to warm temperatures

- Heat/Cold Intolerance:** affected by changes in temperature

- Exercise Intolerance:** unable to participate in activities that involve exertion

- Gastrointestinal Problems:** stomach pain, nausea, diarrhea, cramping, frequent bowel movements or constipation
